MODULE 2

İŞKUR and Navigating the Labor Market in Türkiye

This module provides humanitarian and social sector practitioners with both foundational knowledge and practical skills to effectively engage with Türkiye's public employment system (İŞKUR) and support refugee and migrant populations in accessing services..

Learning objectives

- Understand İŞKUR's mandate, structure, core services, and eligibility criteria
- Navigate registration processes and documentation requirements for refugees and migrants
- Support clients in completing İŞKUR registration and using the online portal and appointment systems
- Identify and access active labour market programmes, including vocational training, job placement, and entrepreneurship support
- Apply legal frameworks related to work permits and employment rights of under Temporary Protection (TP)
- Troubleshoot common barriers to access, including documentation and system challenges
- Develop and strengthen referral pathways and institutional relationships with local İŞKUR offices

Target audience: Case managers, protection officers, social workers, government employment staff

Duration: 1 day **Format:** In-person / Online

MODULE 3

Responsible Practices under EU Regulations

Equips organisations operating in or with Türkiye's EU-aligned regulatory environment to understand and apply key compliance obligations.

Learning objectives

- Understand the key EU regulatory instruments applicable to Turkish civil society and corporations (GDPR, CSRD, CSDDD)
- Apply GDPR-aligned data protection principles to beneficiary data management
- Implement due diligence frameworks for human rights and supply chain compliance
- Develop organisational ESG reporting and sustainability practices
- Integrate EU compliance requirements into programme design and donor reporting
